During the pandemic, the federal government allowed all students to eat free at schools. This was in place spring of 21 and last school year. In compliance with the Missing Children Information Act the school must make a reasonable effort to notify the parent/guardian by 24 telephone of a student's absence as soon as the absence is noted or by 10:00 am if the school has not already been notified by the parent/guardian. This will allow authorities to get an earlier start on tracking missing children.
