First and Second Grades are working on: How to Get Good at Something/ What Mistakes Tell us/ Helpful and Unhelpful Thoughts/ Healthy Self- Talk

Third and Fourth Grades are discovering how to Set a Goal/ Make a Plan/ Check your Progress

Fifth Grade worked on **Goal Setting** but have since moved on to discovering their **Balanced Brain** and **Managing Strong Emotions** 

Sixth Graders are exploring Growth Mindset and How to grow their Brain
